MARI COPENY

Social Justice Ambassador



Mari Copeny is most well known as "Little Miss Flint" - she first gained national attention in 2016, when at the age of 8, the LA Times published a letter she wrote to President Obama challenging him to visit Flint, Michigan. The letter sparked an urgent dialogue around the clean water crisis and environmental racism that was impossible to ignore, ultimately leading to meetings with Presidents Obama and Clinton, Bernie Sanders, and spotlights by TIME Magazine, The Washington Post, NBC News, and VICE.

In the wake of her note to Obama, her work in the community and successful crowdfunding campaigns have allowed her to distribute over 1M bottles of water to Flint residents, raise over \$500K for her 'Flint Kids' projects to place thousands of books into the hands of local children, and distribute backpacks filled with supplies to school-age youth. She's partnered with water filter company Hydroviv to donate and distribute high-capacity lead removal filters to families and child-centric organizations in Flint.

Mari was named to the U.S. Delegation to the 65th Session of the UN Commission on the Status of Women. She is the youngest delegate ever selected to the UN Commission. She's also a Youth Ambassador to the Women's March on Washington and the National Climate March, sits on the board of directors for Kid Box, and is an active member of 18 x Eighteen, an initiative to get young people to vote once they turn 18. In 2019, she received the Shorty Award in Activism.

CHEYENNE TYLER JACOBS

Poetic Activist, Screenwriter & Author



Cheyenne Tyler Jacobs is a Black creative originally from New Jersey. She started breaking ground as @shewillspeak on Instagram, with her writing after the release of her second book The Tragic Type of Beautiful in May 2018. Her words and work started being featured on numerous platforms such as MeTOO, Frolic, AspireTV, N.O.W, and End Rape on Campus. After the release of her second book, she founded the She Will Speak Series which curates bi-annual anthologies. Currently, Cheyenne resides in Atlanta, where and is continuing her work tackling the issues of racism, sexual violence, and homelessness through art and activism.

Cheyenne is a sought-after public speaker, tackling various topics including: Trauma Informed Care; Mental Health First Aide/Awareness; Healing through Art; Advocacy In Young People/Advocacy In Adults; Sexual Violence Prevention; Deeper Look at Institutional Racism; Safety and Support of Black Women (Survivors); 13th Amendment and Mass Incarceration of Black Lives; Activism through Poetry; Curating honest and intersectional platforms; and Rape Culture in Media.
